3. Require at least 2 weeks advance booking. If there are any changes or cancellation, the tour leader is responsible to notify the temple at least 3 days in advance. (If there is any cancellation more than 3 times without notifying the temple, Toronto Fo Guang Shan temple has the right to reject future application.)
4. Groups that have reserved the lunch serving, the group leader or contact person is required to pick-up the lunch ticket from the front desk before the tour. Lunch deposit is \$4 and is non-refundable.
